Logan Square Neighborhood Association has partnered with CPS and Kelvyn Park High School to create and implement a new model of student engagement specifically targeting undocumented students.

The DreamTeam is a student organization that promotes self-advocacy among the immigrant and undocumented population.

Every month the DreamTeam develops an outreach project for students and community members that addresses an issue affecting this population.

Projects have included a student-led professional development work-



shop for teachers, a student panel for new CPS counselors, a workshop on temporary visitor's driver's licenses at a local church and more.

While the DreamTeam works directly with students and teachers to improve access to post-secondary opportunities, students are also connected to policy-change work such as recruiting other students to attend marches and actions and having meetings with politicians to educate them on the importance of passing an immigration reform bill that is humane and keeping families together.
